Hi all,

Thanks for those kind thoughts of people on my few days off, really needed this time to have a break, albeit small and loosen of some cobwebs, so I can plan a little for the future.

Those who could turn up for the HomeFEST, thanks a lot for the fun that we had, it was great to see everyone having a chat as Lifestylers as well as being proud of what we have – even better of what we will have.

One of the busses has arrived – the 25 seater and this will allow a larger number of Lifestylers to be able to have a community time together, Carole and myself will look to get our licenses ASAP so we make great use of this with you all.



Seems the first trip of those lucky ones was a great success and already plans are afoot for the next ones.

The smaller bus will be better for you all to go out yourselves, as it can be driven with a normal car license.

One of the successes of the Village is that we ensure you have some assets to have

a great time, but we will not be around all the time to look after you – as you are Lifestylers and want to do things in your community.

Some of those things will be in the Craft Centre and this is a priority to get up, as well as to finish off the fences and other items as quickly as possible.



Now the detention centre is almost completed with our items, we can put our focus back to the Village and get it to where it should be.

The landscaping will be a focus, with 600mm (2 ft in the old money) white picket fences being placed about 600mm from the road edge, then small pebbles and natives in this area, mainly ground cover, maintained by us to give consistency across the site.

Some people have asked for gates to keep in puppy dogs etc... and these will need to be back at the edge of the home and be the 1,500mm colourbond so they cannot jump over them.

While I was away with my better half – Julie, we travelled to Lismore and had a chat with a company that has controlled systems for puppy dogs and cats, to keep them within controlled (fenced) areas, once I have more information, will send out to all to see if you would like it around your site.

The bloke shed will also need to be a priority, Les and I spied a Pizza Oven from K and D and while others thought Friday Pizza Nights would be great, we thought that the Blokes Shed should have their own, with a special Pizza Fridge (and the Beer Fridge) for educational shows like Footy, Cricket, Boxing, Wrestling etc... - bloke stuff.

All the info is now with the Clarence Council on the Club House and we should be able to start building this in a month or two.

The building site sheds etc... will be moved ASAP and the frontage, gates and car parking can then be completed.

So things are now almost back into focus in the Village and we are well on the way again.
